There were a number of small group and individual mock interview stations. In addition, candidates were given the opportunity to gain constructive individual feedback from experienced Consultants and Speciality Registrars who have recently gone through this process and obtained a training number. Structure and practice is the key to success, and this course provided the delegate with a platform to develop the correct technique to perform well in the interview.




How The Stations Are Set Up (Miss E Blower)




Example Stations and What is Expected of you [Portfolio, Clinical, and Clinical Management] (Mr T Gilbert)




